February 1st – St Brigid's Day - This is heralded as the first day of Spring (Imbolc). Similar to the United States groundhog tradition, if a hedgehog came out of his burrow on St. Brigid's Day.

February 1, 1796 - Theobald Wolf Tone, United Irish leader, arrives in France seeking assistance

February 2, 1880 - Charles S. Parnell addresses the U.S. Congress

February 2, 1882 – James Joyce, Irish author born.

February 4, 1868 - Birth of Irish patriot and revolutionary, Countess

Constance Markievicz, née Gore-Booth.

Constance was the first woman to be elected
to Westminster Parliament in London (where
she refused to take her seat)

February 4, 1775 - Robert Emmet, Irish patriot born.

February 6, 1685 - Coronation of King James II

February 6, 1877 – John O'Mahoney, Irish patriot, died in New York City
